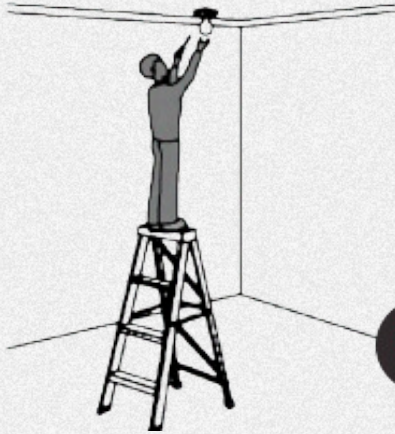
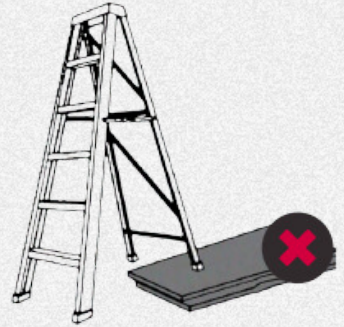


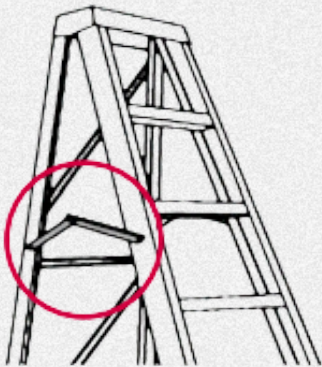
Dos and Don'ts of ladder safety



Don't stand on the top rung! Don't work higher than the third rung.



Don't place your ladder on uneven ground.



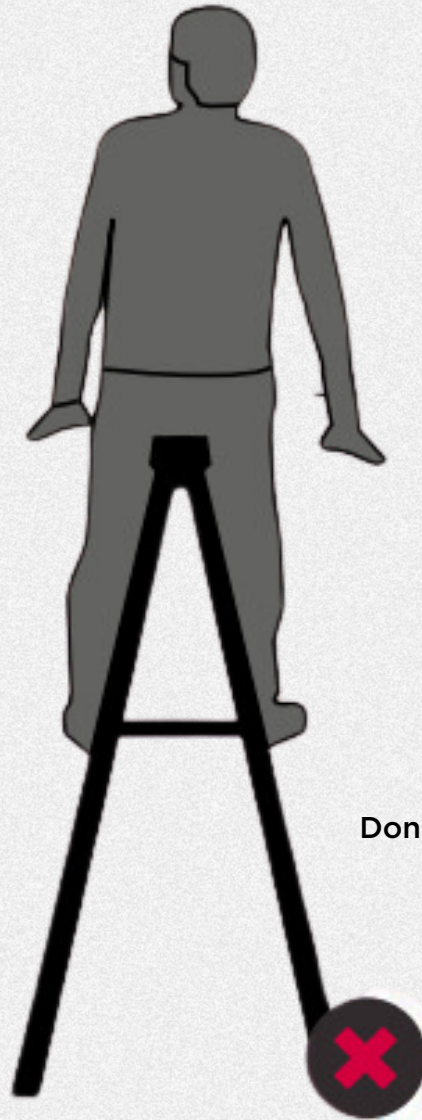
Don't use the ladder if it isn't fully extended.



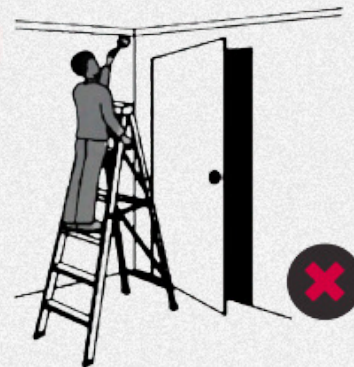
Don't climb a ladder holding tools in your hands.



Don't lean away from the ladder to carry out your task.

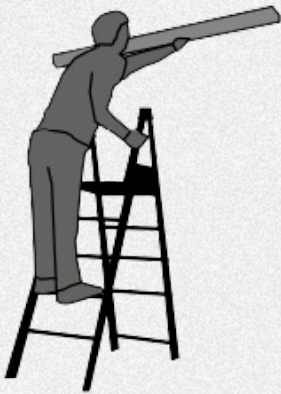

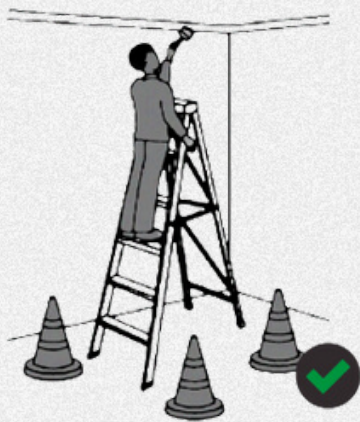


Don't place the ladder where you could get knocked off

Dos and Don'ts of ladder safety



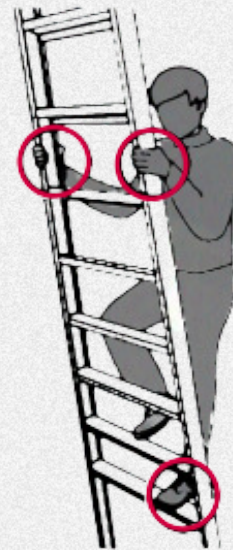
Do have a secure place to hold, no higher than 3rd rung from the top.



Do prevent passers-by from walking under or near the ladder



Do wear proper footwear (non-slip flat shoes).



Do maintain 3 points of contact.

DO...

Check, maintain and store ladders well

Before using a ladder, check it carefully to ensure there are no visible defects and that it is in good working condition. Check the ladder according to the manufacturer's instructions.
